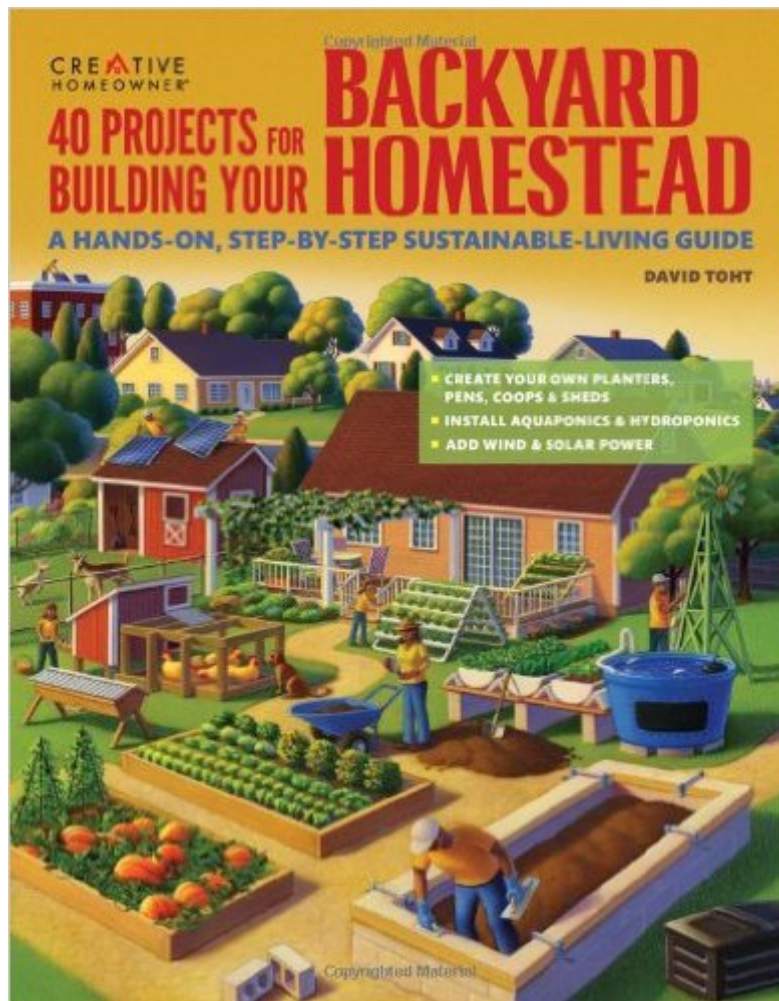

Very basic guide, I was looking for something a bit more technical and in depth. The solar and wind section was very minimal and left a lot to be explained.

This book is easy to read and contains easy step-by-step project with pictures as well as written directions. The variety of projects goes from very easy to more difficult.

This book was okay, but not what I expected. It is definitely in the beginners category. It gives you a good understanding of how to take on small projects like raised beds, and trellis. For the bigger projects it gives you a decent starting point. For some readers this book will be great, but having

been in the building industry for over 20 years I did not find this vary helpful at all. I thought I would get detailed plans and informations on projects like root cellars and efficient greenhouses. Again this good is a great beginners book, but not for an advanced D I Y person.

This book is a good basic book to give you tips and suggestions to starting out the backyard homestead. The plans seem easy to build but there is a lot of information on raised bed gardens.
